

Findings - The Peace Index - September 2023

The Peace Index is conducted by Dr. Nimrod Rosler of The International Program in Conflict Resolution and Mediation and Dr. Alon Yakter from the School of Political Science, Government and International Affairs at Tel Aviv University.

The survey was conducted in Hebrew and in Arabic by the iPanel research institute between August 29 and September 5, 2023 among 612 respondents: 510 Jewish respondents and 102 Arab respondents. Calculations were adjusted so that the respondents would constitute a representative national sample of the adult population aged 18 and above. Maximum sampling error: +/- 4.2%




