## Findings - The Peace Index- May 2020

The Peace Index is conducted by Dr. Nimrod Rosler and Prof. Ephraim Yaar from the International Program in Conflict Resolution and Mediation at Tel Aviv University.

The survey was conducted by iPanel between 18-23 May 2020 among 613 respondents, 509 Jewish respondents and 104 Arab respondents. The survey was carried out in Hebrew and Arabic. Calculations were adjusted so that the respondents would constitute a representative national sample of the adult population aged 18 and above. Maximum margin of error for the entire sample is $+/-4.1 \%$
