






If a polluting accident happens in your living area, what would be your first choice of action?



















How much harm do you think pollution causes to your personal health?








Which is more important: economic development or environmental protection?














Chinese central government officials should be directly elected by the people, do you agree?











Do you think the Chinese government is transparent with environmental issues?




